

Guidelines for WNC Tournament Play

1. Use Rawlings CAL or BRO Baseballs
2. Play each game to conclusion. Suspended game will pick up at point of suspension.
3. 10 run rule is in effect for all games.
4. Any suspended game shall be played prior to either team's next scheduled game. This does not mean that other games cannot be played before it is finished, it just means that you have to finish that game prior to the next game that involves either of those 2 teams. (pool play only)
5. Any game postponed prior to its' start may be rescheduled at the discretion of the Series Director. (pool play only, in bracket play a game must be finished prior to the start of the next game.)
6. Keep and post all standings in each pool. Maintain runs scored and runs allowed statistics and post. Email all scores at least daily to scores@wncbr.org . Please include age group and field size.
7. Furnish officials scorekeeper and maintain pitching records. Warn the home plate umpire if a player is about to pitch too many innings. Please instruct your umpires to at that point advise the manager of that team.
8. For pitching, the start of the bracket play is not a new tournament. Pitching limitations apply.
9. No EH is allowed.
10. No courtesy runners or speed up rules.
11. No automatic walks. Pitcher must throw 4 balls.
12. No local league rules.
13. Please have a 3 man protest committee at the site. When there is a protest, stop the game, get the explanation from the umpire and the protesting manager. Then meet as a three person committee, no coaches, umpires, best friends, and make a decision. After the decision is made, call 704 289 2451 or 704 880 4789 or 704 219 2955 and get a confirmation. After that give the decision to the umpire and managers.
