

WNC Babe Ruth Regulation Clarifications

- A. Babe Ruth League has no "Must Slide Rule". Refer to Babe Ruth League's "Contact Rule".
- B. A waiver is required for any rule or regulations not adhered to. (Request through your District Commissioner). This is a must! The State Commissioner will not approve any waiver without the signatures of the League Presidents and District Commissioners.
- C. Notarized copies of a Birth Record are not an acceptable "proof of age" for tournament play.
- D. The player limitations are to be adhered to. (Number of certain ages on a roster)
- E. Minimum of 12 players per team, regular season and tournament.
- F. Rookie league tournament rules are as approved by the Southeast Region.
- G. Please note Local League Options should be in writing when approved.
- H. Per rules, any player, manager, or coach warming up a pitcher at home plate shall wear a mask. It is recommended anyone warming up a pitcher at any location wears a mask.
- I. There is no Designated Hitter in Babe Ruth League.
- J. The State Commissioner or his appointed representative is in charge of the State Tournaments. It is his responsibility to see that the Tournaments are conducted by the rules and regulations of Babe Ruth League, Inc. and the WNC Babe Ruth League Tournament Contract. Only these persons are authorized to rule on the eligibility of a player or coach in the State Tournament games.
- K. Any player or coach ejected from a game is not automatically out of the tournament or the next game. This decision is limited to the player's parents, coach, league president, state commissioner or his appointed representative.
- L. The umpires in the State Tournament are under the supervision of the State Umpire Agent, State Commissioner or his appointed representative, and the Tournament UIC (umpire in chief).
